If your child is new to the school, please bring the following items on your scheduled orientation day. If your child is a returning student, please bring supplies on the first day of school.

*Please do not label any school supplies, as they are shared by all students at the school.*

### **For New & Returning Parents:**

1. Nap mattress (all returning students will need a new nap mattress)
2. Flat sheet (any size – not crib sheet)
3. Pillow
4. Sun Shirt and hat/cap for outdoor activities

### **For All Parents:**

1. A complete change of clothing. If your child has occasional accidents, please send more than one change of clothes.
  - Clothes should be appropriate for the season
2. A pair of rubber boots for horticulture exercise.
  - Must fit, be in good condition and comfortable for the student to wear.
  - For returning students: Parents please check any boots you are reusing for the year to ensure that the inside lining is in good condition, as well as the outside of the boot.
3. A pair of simple house slippers.
  - To avoid distractions and competition among students, we strongly discourage slippers with enlarged cartoon characters or features. The plainer, the better. Must fit, be in good condition and comfortable for the student to wear.
4. A house plant with leaves in a container that holds water.
  - Please label the container with the name of the plant.
5. Large-sized box of tissue.
  - Provide this 3X per year: August, November, March
6. Three boxes of Ziploc bags: 1-gallon size, 1-sandwich size, 1-snack size
7. One three-pack of baby wipes **refills**, for sensitive skin types, if possible.
8. Large plastic nap bag (Blue Ziploc Flexible Totes 10 gallon size – XL)
9. Set of Water Color Paints with Brush
10. 2 Boxes of Markers (1-Thin Tip, 1-Thick Tip)
11. Medium-Sized Bag of Craft Materials (Embellishments) with flat surface for gluing; no adhesive backings, please.
